Ever, only, all for Thee, Ever, only, all for Thee

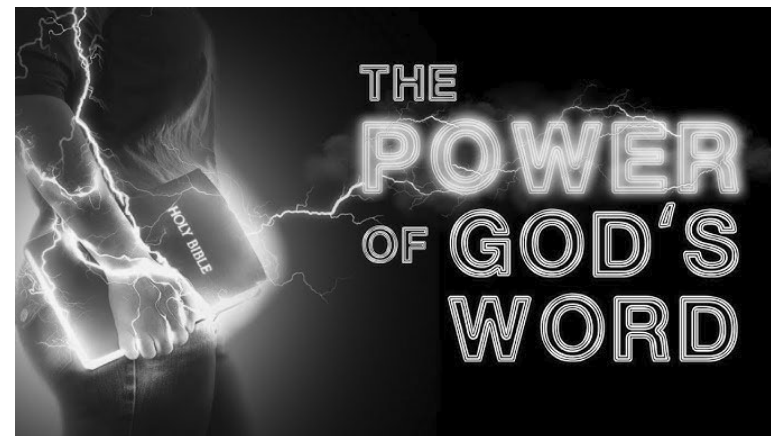
