 Seal it for Thy courts above.

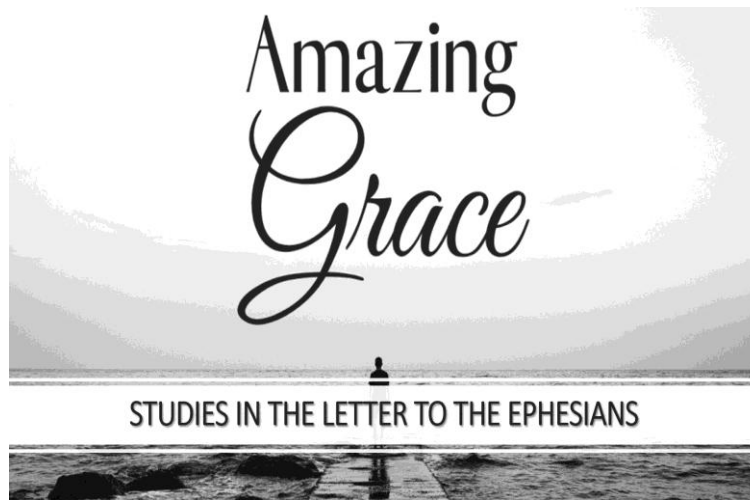
